The film also contains references to Yevgeny Zamyatin's novel "We", which heavily influenced George Orwell. The film combines various genres; grotesque, black comedy, drama, philosophical allegory.

"1984" is an example of a true auteur cinema, as Diana Ringo is a producer, director, screenwriter, cameraman, editor, composer and performer of one of the main roles.
